The entire surface of this precious ammonite is covered with ammolite, a material considered a precious gem and intended for fine jewelry. Already known and appreciated by the Blackfoot tribesmen who used them as sacred ornaments for the rites preceding the great buffalo hunts and thus supposed to bring full success and happiness to all the companies of the clan, they were also used for medicinal as could be for us in the West the bezoar or the defense of narwhal. This extremely bright and iridescent gemstone comes exclusively from the southern province of Alberta, Canada. It was officially recognized as a valuable gemstone in the same way as Opal in 1981 by the International Confederation of Jewelery. This ammonite is distinguished among all its sisters by the intensity of its iridescence and the magnificence of its shimmering colors formed of green, purple, blue, red and finally yellow. 描述: Ammonoids are a group of cephalopod mollusc fossils protected by a very elongated cone-shaped, often spirally curved shell. This shell has a portion divided into rooms by partitions. Appeared in the middle of the primary era, about 400 million years ago, they populated the oceans and seas of the globe. They all disappeared at the end of the secondary era, 65 million years ago, at the same time as the dinosaurs. Although of slightly different diameter and possibly resulting from a second cut for one of the slices, these two spectacular cuts of ammonite present the same hues of fossilization, the same outlines of the boxes and finally the same crystallizations in the latter. Mineralization in honey-colored calcite.
